

# Panhandle Drop-off / Pick-up Guidelines

## Shuttle from Lincolnwood to Farmersville or Prek-1<sup>st</sup> grade students

PreK-1<sup>st</sup> grade bus riders will be transported to school on their normal bus route, then transfer to the FGS shuttle bus in front of the Lincolnwood Gymnasium entrance.

All other PreK-1<sup>st</sup> grade students will catch the shuttle to FGS in front of the gym doors.

**Students can wait for the shuttle in the hallway by the gym doors. The shuttle leaves for FGS at 7:40 am. If catching the shuttle at Lincolnwood, please arrive no later than 7:35 am.**

These students will return to Raymond at the end of the school day for connection to their regular transportation home.

## Shuttle from Farmersville Grade School to Raymond for 2<sup>nd</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students

Two busses will transport 2<sup>nd</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> grades students from Farmersville Grade School to Raymond. This shuttle leaves the grade school approximately 7:25 am. If catching this shuttle, please arrive no later than 7:20 a.m. These students will return to FGS at the end of the day.

## Lincolnwood Parking Lot Rules

- All vehicles dropping off at Lincolnwood and Raymond Grade School should **enter thru the campus' northern most entrance and exit to the south.** Vehicles should not linger in the bus drop off area.
- Students being picked up from the Lincolnwood building should follow the same rules
- Students being picked up from the Raymond Grade School building will be dismissed from the back door (southern end of the building). Vehicles will line up at the entrance to the parking lot to wait for the shuttle bus to go thru. Walkers and bike riders are dismissed last after bus and vehicle traffic has cleared.

**PARENTS at BOTH SCHOOLS: Please drop off or pick-up students BEHIND any busses that are unloading or loading. Students should NOT walk between, alongside, or in front of any busses. Be aware of all traffic and make sure your children look before both ways before crossing the parking lot or road.**

**For rural students: Please call the bus garage by 6 am if your child will not be riding that day.**

## Important

**The laws regarding passing a stopped school bus with Stop Arm and red flashing lights activated apply to the school busses loading and unloading in front of the school.**

**Stop-Arm Cameras are in the process of being added to Panhandle busses. These cameras will record the license plate of any vehicle that passes a stopped school bus with the stop arm and red flashing lights activated. This includes busses loading in the parking lot at the school.**

Illinois law provides that the driving privileges of a person convicted of passing a stopped school bus will be suspended for **three months** for the first offense and one year for the second, if the second conviction occurs within five years.
