Dear Parents, Students, and Friends,


There are occasionally times when students or parents would like to provide information to a school but hesitate because they do not want their identities known. Providing open, direct communication with the community has long been a basic practice for Panhandle School District. Our district, in partnership with the Montgomery County Emergency Management Agency, the local Montgomery County 708 Board, as well as the other three School Districts in Montgomery County, now offers the Safe School Helpline®, another method to allow parents and community members to provide input.

The Safe School Helpline® is designed to assist you in reporting any wrongdoing that impacts our schools, our students, or our staff – anonymously, so as to protect your privacy. For example, you may wish to report acts of violence, theft, drug, or alcohol use, weapons or sexual harassment.

Just call from a touch-tone phone to 1-800-4-1-VOICE, ext. 359 (418-6423) to leave your information. Or text 66746 then type TIPS. Your message will not be traced, and you will not be identified. The Safe School Helpline® team will transcribe and fax your message to school officials, so appropriate action can be taken.
