

Thomas H. Moore Illinois Electric Cooperative Memorial Scholarship Program

The Illinois Electric Cooperative (IEC) Memorial Scholarship Program awards fifteen \$2,000 scholarships annually to deserving students in the "electric cooperative family" entering college to assist them with their educational costs.

Only one completed application is necessary to apply to both the MJM Scholarship Program and the Thomas H. Moore Illinois Electric Cooperatives (IEC) Memorial Scholarship Program, and students who apply are eligible to win scholarships from both programs.

About the scholarships

- scholarships are awarded to high school students who are the child of an Illinois electric cooperative member receiving service from the cooperative (deadline to apply Dec. 31, 2022).
- scholarships are reserved for high school students enrolling full-time at a two-year Illinois community college who are the child of Illinois electric cooperative members, employees or directors (deadline to apply Dec. 31, 2022).
- scholarship, the Earl W. Struck Memorial Scholarship, is awarded to a high school student who is the child of an Illinois electric cooperative employee or director (deadline to apply Dec. 31, 2022).
- scholarship, the LaVern and Nola McEntire Lineworker's Scholarship, is awarded to a student to attend the lineworker's school conducted by the Association of Illinois Electric Cooperatives in conjunction with Lincoln Land Community College, Springfield, IL (deadline to apply April 30, 2023).
