Special Session Minutes August 4, 2022

The Panhandle Board of Education met in special session on Thursday, August 4, 2022 at the Panhandle Unit Office in Raymond at 6:30 p.m.

Discussion and action relating for the Lincolnwood parking lot renovation.

The board discussed the need to replace concrete sidewalks sections along the front of Lincolnwood. Mr. Hopper provided information regarding the estimated cost, \$9250.00 for the work. The board also discussed adding a concrete pad for the dumpster at Lincolnwood with an estimated cost of \$2000.00.

Mr. Hopper also discussed the quote to install commemorative pavers under the canopy at Lincolnwood. The board requested more information before making a decision regarding the project.

It was moved by Slightom and seconded by Pitchford to approve concrete work not to exceed \$12,000.00. Motion carried 7-0.


It was moved by Pitchford and seconded by Brown to approve Zach Wieland as assistant soccer coach for the 2022-2023 season. Motion carried 7-0.
