Online Registration FAQ

- Who can use on-line registration?
 - Parents/Guardians of students who were enrolled during the past 22-23 school year.
 - Parents/Guardians of families new to the Panhandle School District.
- I already have children in the district. How do I add a new student from my family (such as a kindergartener, etc.)?

The option to add a new student is available when you register your current student(s). If your new student is a preschooler, preschool students must complete a screening and be approved before registering online.

My family is new to the Panhandle District. How do I register my students?

Go to www.panhandleschools.com, scroll over the "Information" tab and click "Online Registration 23-24" select "New Student Registration". After submitting the requested information, you will receive a welcome email with information on how to complete the registration process.

What is required for online registration?

If your student was enrolled in 22-23, you must have access to your child's school TeacherEase account.

How do I know if I have access?

If you have checked your student's grades or lunch balance online, you have access.

What if I have never checked my child's account or have forgotten how?

Contact your school's office. You will need to provide a valid email address.

Can I pay registration fees and put money on my child's lunch account?

Yes, using any major credit card. A convenience fee will be added to each transaction to offset the cost of the service.

Do I have to pay registration fees online when I register?

No. Payment of registration fees can still be done by check/cash.

What if I do not have internet access or have other difficulties with online registration?

If you are unable to register on-line, you can schedule an appointment for in-person registration by calling the district office at 217-229-4215. In-person registration will be held on Thursday, August 3 from 3pm-6pm.

Parents will still be required to provide additional documents such as proof of school/sports physicals, dental/eye exams, medication forms, etc. A list of required school forms and the grades they pertain to are available at the following: www.panhandleschools.com/district/registration-information.

Completed forms can be mailed, scanned and emailed, delivered in-person, or sent with your student on the first day of school.
